

## DROUGHT UPDATE – WATER RESTRICTIONS

Great support and response from you, our customer, along with recent rains and improved stream flows have led to a reduction in the level of restrictions for SJWD Water District customers. Effective immediately, the following examples of outdoor water usage **are acceptable**:

- Irrigation of lawns, plants, and trees (preferably in the early morning hours)
- Filling or maintaining public or private swimming pools
- Washing vehicles
- Maintaining fountains or decorative water bodies
- Washing buildings or other structures

Customers are advised to continue to **conserve** where possible and only use water outdoors as necessary on the following **mandatory** schedule:

Customers with street addresses, box numbers, or rural numbers ending in even numbers (0, 2, 4, 6 or 8) and locations without address should use water outdoors **only on Thursdays and Sundays**. For example, a customer with the address 220 Main Street would use water outdoors on Thursday and Sunday only.

Customers with street addresses, box numbers, or rural numbers ending in odd numbers (1, 3, 5, 7 or 9) should use water outdoors **only on Wednesdays and Saturdays**. For example, a customer with the address 221 Main Street would use water outdoors on Wednesday and Saturday only.
